In accordance with the provisions of Article 234(1)(i) of ASF Regulation no. 5/2018 on issuers of financial instruments and market operations and Law no. 24/2017 on issuers of financial instruments and market operations,

Connections Consult S.A. announces the conclusion of two significant subsequent contracts with a public institution in Romania, related to the framework agreement no. 848/11 of 19.09.2025. Each of them has as its object migration services of cybersecurity applications and hardware and software accessories. The first subsequent contract is worth RON 99,146,000 excluding VAT, and the second subsequent contract has a value of RON 43,888,000 excluding VAT.

Each of the two contracts has a duration of 28 months and covers the delivery of software equipment and licenses, migration services, installation and configuration of applications and systems (including infrastructure and AI systems) as well as maintenance and technical support. The two winning projects demonstrate the group's strong commitment to development in the direction of artificial intelligence and cybersecurity.
