AQUILA strengthens its distribution infrastructure in southeastern Romania by relocating to a new logistics center in Constanța

Ploiești, September, 10, 2026: AQUILA (BVB: [AQ](#)), one of the largest players in the fast-moving consumer goods distribution sector in Romania and the region, is relocating its operations in Constanța to a new logistics center, following an investment of over EUR 500,000.

With a total area of over 6,000 sqm and nearly four times the storage capacity of the previous location, the new logistics center strengthens AQUILA's infrastructure in southeastern Romania and expands the company's capacity to handle product categories with different logistics requirements. The location facilitates the efficient servicing of customers across Constanța and Tulcea counties, including the Black Sea coast and the Danube Delta, while its proximity to the Port of Constanța provides an advantage in managing import and distribution flows.

Răzvan Bagherea, Organization and Human Resources Director, AQUILA:

"The relocation of our Constanța operations supports AQUILA's continued development and enables us to align our operational capabilities with the Group's current scale and complexity. The new logistics center provides the capacity and flexibility required to manage an increasingly diverse portfolio across multiple temperature categories and to support the development of the channels in which we operate, including HoReCa. These capabilities create opportunities to further expand our portfolio, attract new partners and grow our customer base."

Expanded capacity for a diversified portfolio

The new center has a storage capacity of over 4,000 pallet for ambient products and more than 2,000 pallet for chilled and frozen products. The facility layout allows for



the separation of flows and the handling, within the same facility, of product categories with different temperature and handling requirements.

The truck loading docks, equipped with hydraulic dock levellers, allow multiple vehicles to be loaded and unloaded simultaneously, helping reduce handling times and improve the efficiency of logistics flows.

The center is equipped with full LED lighting, modern climate control systems, a fire detection system and its own high-capacity backup generator. The freezing systems use CO₂, a natural refrigerant with a lower environmental impact.

Infrastructure supporting portfolio growth and distribution channel development

The investment in Constanța supports AQUILA's strategy to diversify its portfolio and further develop its distribution channels, including HoReCa, where portfolio complexity and the need to operate across multiple temperature categories require specific logistics capabilities.

The location of the new logistics center enables the company to efficiently serve both the retail channel and HoReCa customers across a region characterised by significant seasonal activity along the Black Sea coast and in the Danube Delta.

At the same time, the ability to handle products across ambient, chilled and frozen temperature categories enables AQUILA to integrate new product categories, expand its portfolio and provide suppliers with access to a broader range of distribution channels and customers.

The relocation of the Constanța operations continues AQUILA's logistics network modernization process, following the opening of the new logistics center in Bacău in May. By developing its infrastructure and operational capabilities, AQUILA is strengthening its distribution platform to integrate new product categories and provide partners with access to multiple sales channels in Romania and across the region.

About AQUILA

AQUILA is one of the largest players in the fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) distribution sector in Romania and the region, operating an integrated business model that covers distribution, logistics, and transportation across multiple temperature categories, for both food and non-food products, as well as production activities.

With a presence in Romania, the Republic of Moldova and Hungary, AQUILA ensures the availability of a portfolio of over 22,000 products across more than 78,000 points of sale, supported by a logistics infrastructure and distribution network spanning modern retail, traditional trade, HoReCa and other sales channels.

AQUILA's portfolio includes international brands such as Kinder, Lavazza, Whiskas and Mutti, alongside its own brands, Gradena, LaMasă, Yachtis and JetXpert. The company's growth strategy focuses on portfolio diversification, expanding its distribution and logistics capabilities, and strengthening its regional presence.



In 2025, AQUILA recorded record revenues of approximately RON 3.5 billion, up 18% compared to the previous year, supported by the strengthening of the distribution segment, portfolio diversification and the development of its own brands.

Founded in 1994 and listed on the Bucharest Stock Exchange in November 2021 under the ticker symbol AQ, AQUILA is included in the Bucharest Stock Exchange's benchmark BET index, as well as in the MSCI Frontier and MSCI Romania indices.

The company achieved the maximum VEKTOR by ARIR score of 10, which assesses listed companies' investor communication, and was awarded the EcoVadis Silver Medal in 2025 for its sustainability performance.

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
