**Important events to be reported:** Participation in the “Romania Industry Day” event organized at the NATO Headquarters

The management of Safetech Innovations S.A. (hereinafter referred to as the “Company”) informs investors about the Company’s participation in the “Romania Industry Day” event, organized for the first time at the NATO headquarters in Brussels. The initiative aims to facilitate interaction between Romanian companies and relevant Alliance structures in the context of procurement and development programs.

The event, inaugurated on April 20, 2026, brings together companies operating in areas such as cybersecurity, technology, and the defense industry and includes presentation sessions, working meetings, and consultations with representatives of NATO structures with responsibilities in fields such as communications, security, and operational support, including specialized agencies of the Alliance. The Company’s participation aims to present its capabilities and initiate discussions regarding potential directions for collaboration.

Safetech Innovations was present within the delegation, with its participation providing access to a specific institutional framework, distinct from the traditional commercial environment, as well as to a better understanding of the requirements applicable to projects carried out within NATO, including those related to security and compliance standards.

For the Company, participation in such events primarily serves a positioning role and the exploration of potential medium-term opportunities, in a context where cybersecurity
